Thus, the capital campaign is focused on renewing the sanctuary and increasing the height of the porte cochère for better accessibility.

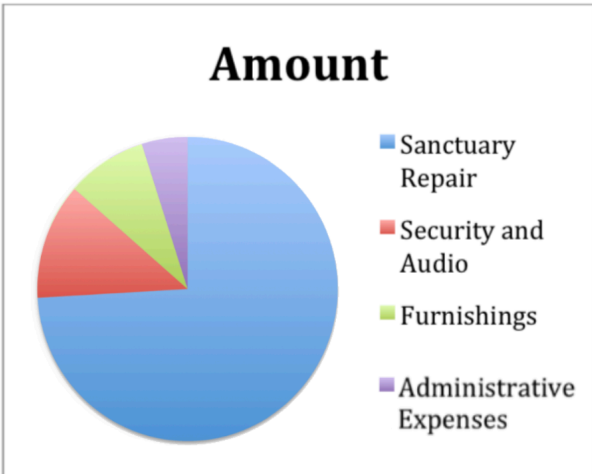
This pledge of support is separate from any annual stewardship pledge. Many of us will give from our assets such as stocks, or items of value.
