### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION and INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your interest in the Nu 'uanu Congregational Church (NCC) Scholarship Program. Nu 'uanu Congregational Church awards scholarships to deserving applicants who are enrolled in or accepted for enrollment in accredited institutions of higher learning, such as a college or university. The purpose of this scholarship is to provide funds to qualified applicants to further their education consistent with the goals and objectives of Nu `uanu Congregational Church and the United Church of Christ. Scholarship awards will be based on available funds, the applicant's academic record, relationship with Nu `uanu Congregational Church and/or another congregation in the United Church of Christ, and the statement of goals and philosophy.

The decision to award any funds to an applicant, including the amount of any scholarship, is subject to the discretion of the NCC Scholarship Committee (Committee). All applicants must comply with the requirements set forth below to maintain eligibility and consideration for a scholarship award from NCC.

### **Eligibility**

The Nu'uanu Congregational Church Scholarship is available to <u>undergraduate</u> college or university students who are members, families, and friends of Nu'uanu Congregational Church.

### Applicants must submit the following

- 1. Application form
- 2. Applicant's personal essay
- 3. Two letters of recommendation from each of the following sources
  - a. A teacher, professor, guidance counselor or other school official
  - b. An individual the applicant knows well through church, through a volunteer service activity, or from an employer.
- 4. A sealed official transcript which includes completed Spring Quarter/Semester grades.
- 5. Applicant will maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher.

### **Due Date and Methods of Delivery**

All applications and supporting documentation listed above must be completed and submitted in **one packet by June 14, 2024**. Acceptable methods of delivery are (1) via the United States Postal Service, or (2) hand delivery.

- 1. United States Postal Service: If sent via United States Postal Service, the packet must be postmarked by **Monday**, **June 10**, **2024** and sent to Nu'uanu Congregational Church, 2651 Pali Highway, Honolulu HI 96817.
- 2. Hand delivery. If submitted via hand delivery, the packet must be received at Nu'uanu Congregational Church, 2651 Pali Highway, Honolulu, HI 96817, no later than **4:00 p.m.** (close of the business day) on **Friday, June 14, 2024**.

Applications and supporting documents must meet the above requirements.

No exceptions shall be made.

Nu'uanu Congregational Church is a 501 (C) (3) church. We are, required by the Internal Revenue Service to show that these funds are used exclusively for educational expenses. The scholarship check will be sent to the recipient's educational institution. Applicants must provide us with (1) the name of the appropriate office to which any scholarship check should be sent and (2) the applicant's student identification number or the last four digits of the applicant's social security number to ensure that the check is credited.

Scholarship recipients <u>must</u> maintain full-time enrollment status as defined by their academic institution. If, at any time following the award, the recipient is not able to maintain full-time enrollment status for <u>any</u> reason, the recipient <u>must</u> inform the committee in writing within seven (7) calendar days of such a change in status. Failure to inform the committee of such a change in status will result in forfeiture of all monies previously awarded, and the recipient may not apply for any future scholarship awards by the Committee. By accepting any scholarship funds from the Committee, the applicant acknowledges, understands, and agrees that he or she will return the full amount of the scholarship award previously granted by the Committee within one-hundred twenty (120) calendar days of such a change in academic status.
